The summer is spent outdoors completing physical, labor-intensive conservation projects in state and local parks, mountain areas and national forests. Example projects include trail building, community gardening and fire mitigation. Weekly educational, civic engagement and team building activities make this Leadership and Conservation Program an engaging and rewarding experience for those committed to national service.
