Qualifications

Education: High School Diploma or equivalency required.

Requirements:

- Belief in and strong support of Mile High Youth Corps' mission, vision, and values
- Ability to complete tasks in a detailed and timely manner
- Must be eligible to legally work in the United States, which will be confirmed using the Federal E-Verify system
- Ability to pass a pre-employment background check, including an FBI Background Check, which includes fingerprinting
- Ability to work well with people from diverse backgrounds
- Technologically proficient, including experience with computer and data management programs (MS Word, MS Excel, Access, etc.). Experience with database systems preferred
- Ability to work well independently and in a team
- Pre-employment drug screen may be required

Hours, Compensation, and Benefits

- This is a one-year, 12 month, full-time AmeriCorps VISTA position (subject to VISTA restrictions) that pays an annual living stipend of \$17,541.16, equating to approximately \$674.66 bi-weekly before taxes.
- Week day office hours are typically 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Thursday and 8 am to 4 pm on Fridays.
- \$6,195 Ed Award or \$1,800 stipend upon completion
- Optional enrollment in the AmeriCorps VISTA Healthcare Allowance program.
- 10 sick days and 10 vacation days
- Opportunities for professional development training throughout the year
- Relocation allowance of \$750 plus 40 cents per mile provided by the Corporation
- Child care allowance provided by the Corporation
