Communications Specialist: Part-Time

Summary: For over 29 years, Mile High Youth Corps (MHYC) has transformed lives, communities and the environment through meaningful youth development and service programs rooted in conservation and the community. The Communications department is currently seeking a part-time Communications Specialist (approximately 15-20 hours/week) to provide marketing and outreach support to the organization. Mile High Youth Corps has a unique need to provide communications to multiple stakeholder groups including donors, young adults interested in participating in programs, project partners and other potential supporters. This position will need an individual able to adapt messaging and communication platforms to meet the varied needs of the outward facing communications of MHYC. Primary areas of responsibility for this new position include overseeing the social media platforms for the agency. helping to plan and execute marketing campaigns to support outreach and recruitment of Corpsmembers (program participants) and general communication support across program departments. This position will work across program departments to gather and adapt information for messaging to different market segmentations in the greater community. Applicants must be able to adapt to an evolving environment and thrive in an autonomous and deadline-oriented workplace.

Reports to: Director of Development & Communications

Essential Functions:

- In partnership with the Director of Development & Communications, develop and implement an editorial calendar for social media platforms that effectively tell the story and highlight impact.
- Create a monthly e-newsletter, working across departments to gather content for inclusion. Analyze email marketing results used to re-tool future emails.
- Manage logistics for marketing and outreach of programs:
 - o Inclusion of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion principles in all communications internal and external
 - o Electronic hiring ads
 - o Maintain a calendar for recruitment
 - Highlight Corpsmembers experience through virtual storytelling on communication platforms
 - o Work closely with outside design consultant to ensure visually appealing collateral supports outreach efforts in community.
- Keep website current and relevant. Monitor and report website traffic and flow.
- Support management of MHYC giving campaigns throughout the year (direct

- mail, workplace giving, online giving campaign and cause marketing)
- Represent the agency in community, able to talk about MHYC and encourage potential supporters and applicants to learn more.

<u>Required Experience</u>: Skills in managing social media and developing content. Strong communication skills-verbal and written.

- Ability to set and meet goals.
- Ability to pass pre-employment background check, which includes a FBI criminal background check which requires fingerprinting.
- A pre-employment background check and drug screen required.

Hours & Compensation:

This is a part-time position, approximately 15-20 hours per week/flexible work schedule, \$16.50/hour. Some evenings and weekend hours may be required. This position is not eligible for benefits but will earn paid sick leave.
