Mile High Youth Corps' BIPOC Affinity Crew is for young adults who identify as Black, Indigenous and People of Color. This crew is an opportunity to develop new skills in a supportive environment that actively seeks to celebrate and honor the diverse lived perspectives of BIPOC individuals.

- Earn a total program stipend of \$5,040 for 12-week program or \$5,880 for 14-week program, plus a \$1,638.89 AmeriCorps Education Award (upon program completion)
- Other benefits include: Student Loan Forbearance, Health Insurance, and Mental Health Counseling
- No experience required. Crew members learn technical skills and gain experience while getting paid!
- Program dates: May 10 or 24 through August 13, 2021
